


# National **ECOSOCC** Chapters

WHAT ARE NATIONAL ECOSOCC CHAPTERS?

National ECOSOCC Chapters are branches or local groups of the African Union Economic, Social and Cultural Council (ECOSOCC) established within each African Union (AU) member state. ECOSOCC is a platform that enables civil society to contribute to the work of the AU, particularly in areas related to economic, social, and cultural development.

**National Chapters** provide a platform for civil society organizations (CSOs) in each member state to actively engage with the AU's processes and activities.



#### **Accountability** and Transparency

**National Chapters** enhance accountability by promoting the dissemination of AU's progress and activities to civil societies in each member state.



#### **Capacity-Building**

**National Chapters** facilitate capacitybuilding and training of CSOs, enhancing their ability to contribute effectively to the AU's work.



#### **Local Impact**

By aligning national priorities with AU aspirations, National Chapters amplify the impact of AU initiatives at the local level.
