As ECOSOCC marks its 20th anniversary in July 2024, it reflects on a journey characterised by significant contributions to fostering civic engagement, advancing policy development, and implementing initiatives across Africa. This milestone serves as an opportunity to assess progress in enhancing interaction between the African Union and the continent's citizens, demonstrating two decades of dedication to promoting Pan-African values and driving socio-economic and cultural development across the continent.

- 4. To enhance visibility of the African Peace and Security Architecture (APSA).
- 5. To solicit civil society's insights on democracy and institutional resilience in Africa.
- 6. To facilitate the exchange of policy insights and capacities, fostering collaborative efforts toward Africa's development agenda.
- 7. To synthesize actionable recommendations based on two decades of ECOSOCC's contributions to inform future development plans.
